To make life easier for you by managing your council accounts online, My eAccount has now added over 130 new services in three new sections. In My Street you can report a blocked drain or dumped rubbish, as well as dog fouling and graffiti. In My Recycling and Refuse you can check your recycling collection date, report a missed collection and request a new recycling box. In the new My Benefit section you can view your Council Tax and any Housing Benefits.
