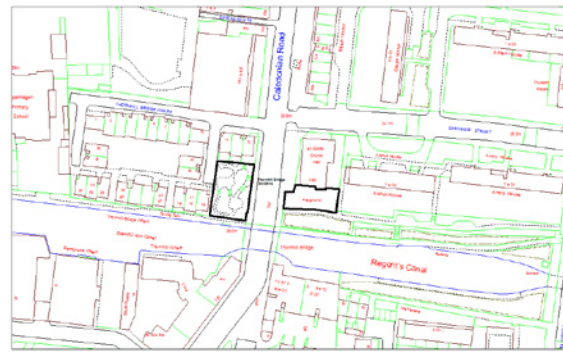

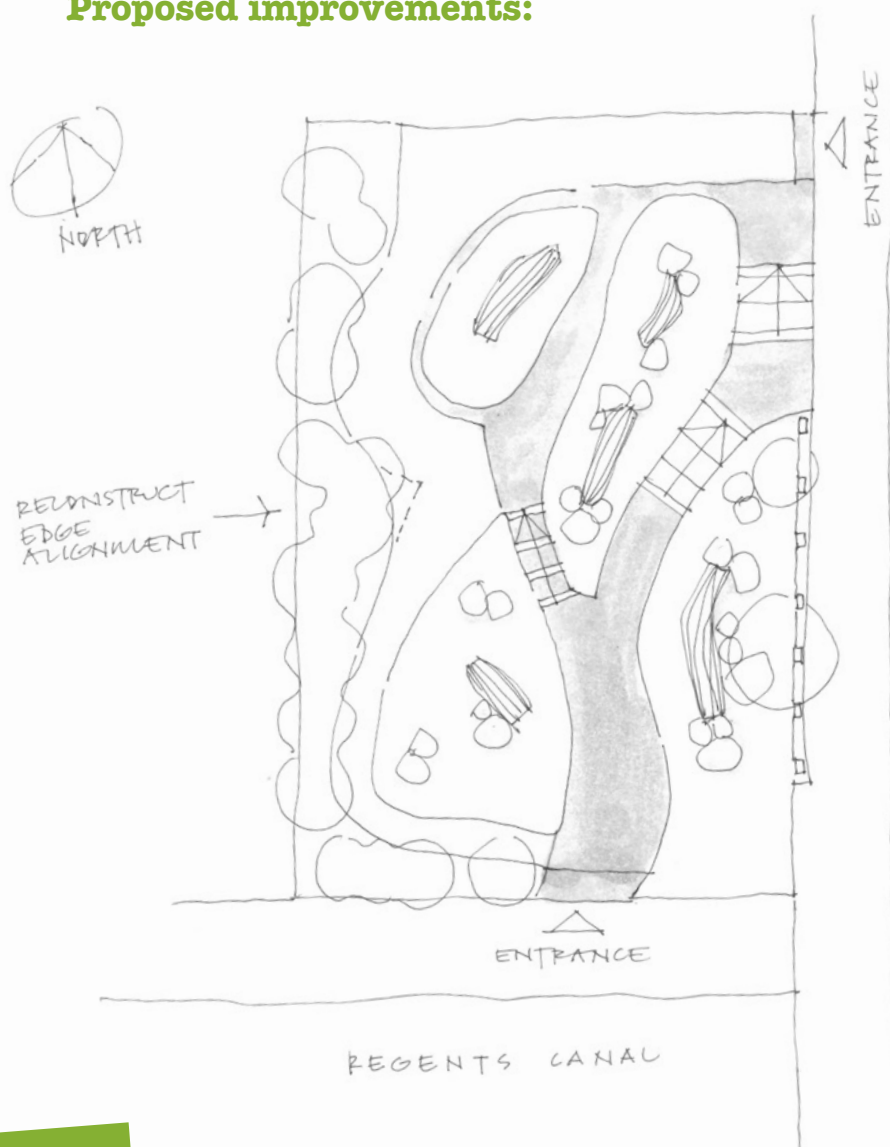
THE SPACE

- ELUNA BLOCKS BLUE
- NEW INFILL SHRUB PLANTING
- LOGS TO ROT AS REFUGE
- NEW BRICK STEP/RAMP
BRICK TO MATCH ADJACENT STEPS
LANDING IN ELUNA
- NATURE WALL
TIMBER BLOCKS WITH MESH AND IVY WALL MOUNTED

NOTES:

- ALL PLANTING RETAINED
- ALL EDGING RETAINED EXCEPT WHERE INDICATED
- BIRD BOXES TO BE INSTALLED
- WOODLAND BULB PLANTING
- SHRUBS TO BE NATIVE AND SHADE TOLERANT:
- BAT BOXES TO BE INSTALLED OR A 'BAT HOTEL'
